Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

1. INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

1.1 We may collect and process the following data about you

- a) Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site "<http://www.dic.co.in>" ("our site"). This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribe to our services, post material, or request further services.
- a) If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- b) We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.
- c) Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, web logs and other communication data, whether this is required for our own purposes or otherwise and the resources that you access.

2. IP ADDRESSES AND COOKIES

2.1 We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

2.2 For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalized service. They enable us:

- a) To estimate our audience size and usage pattern.
- b) To store information about your preferences, and so allow us to customize our site according to your individual interests.

- c) To speed up your searches.

2.3 You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our site.

3. WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

3.1 All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. (No payment transaction is to be routed through the mobile application unless there is specific instruction from the company.

3.2 Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site and any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.

4. USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

4.1 We use information held about you in the following ways:

6. YOUR RIGHTS
