Brief details of litigation viz. name(s) of the opposing party, court/tribunal/agency where litigation is filed, brief details of dispute/litigation	An appeal has been filed by the Principal Commissioner of Income Tax-2, Kolkata before the Hon'ble Kolkata High Court against an order passed by Hon'ble ITAT "C" Bench in favour of the Company. The Income Tax Department has contested the relief given to the Company by ITAT against royalty expenses and transfer pricing adjustment, for the assessment year 2014-15.
	The appeal has been filed by Income Tax Department against the ITAT order after a delay of approx. 2 years.
Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.;	As per the appeal, the disputed tax amount is INR. 2.96 crores. The Company will file a suitable reply after evaluation, once the appeal is admitted by the Hon'ble High Court and the Company is asked to submit its response.
